with the many that Propmakers already possess, this kind of work can stay in-house! It's work which otherwise might be contracted out to non-Local 44 entities.

At the Signatory Prophouse Shops and the Studios that were visited. trained and certified Local 44 Propmakers were using CNC flat-bed cutters, 3D printers, Water Jet and Laser cutting equipment. All of it was computer programmed machinery which needs programmers and operators! They were making custom designed props and furniture out of steel, wood and plastic.

This is something Local 44 Propmakers should seriously think about learning and being certified in. Why?

Because it's rapidly becoming a standard among the services Signatory Studios and Shops are offering and is what Producers and designers are increasingly expecting. Local

"We can do that because we have Propmakers who have those skills. They're trained, certified and ready to go!"

Propmakers should seriously consider taking advantage of these training opportunities with Contract Services when things open back up again and once the course offerings resume. Keep yourself and your skillsets up-to-date. It'll help keep Local 44's Propmakers and their reputations relevant and is another way to keep Union-negotiated wages and benefits flowing, now and in the future!
