Executive Board Unanimously Votes "No Confidence" in President Dutch Merrick's Conduct and Leadership

Dear Members:

As your elected Executive Board Representatives, we are notifying the membership of a vote of no confidence that the Executive Board took based on the ongoing actions of President Merrick. Like many of you, the Executive Board was excited with President Merrick's energy when he was elected. Despite our concerted efforts to work with President Merrick, he has lost our confidence in his actions and judgment as President. Please treat this information as for Local 44 members only and avoid publishing it in any way that makes it available to anyone who is not a Local 44 member.

At a special Board meeting on December 30, 2020, the Executive Board voted unanimously that it has no confidence in President Merrick. To explain our actions, we have provided here the motion of No Confidence, statements endorsed by the Executive Board explaining President Merrick's behavior and a timeline of pertinent events:

"NO CONFIDENCE" MOTION:

Motion brought by Brother Loomer:

"I move that the Executive Board conducts a Vote of No Confidence in President Dutch Merrick's leadership and actions. Accompanying this vote should be a statement in the record that "This Vote of No Confidence is caused by President Merrick's delay tactics and deception with the Local 44 Executive Board concerning his use of Local 44's identity for unapproved purposes, repeated refusal to comply with directives from the Executive Board to provide various intellectual property to Local 44, as well as dishonest and dilatory tactics in dealing with the Board. Furthermore, this vote of no confidence is caused by President Merrick's use of social media to publicize a dishonest and self-serving account of his actions. Therefore, the Executive Board of Local 44 has lost confidence in his ability to honestly, transparently and reasonably conduct himself as President. For these reasons, we take this action and speak in a single voice."

Seconded by the Following Executive Board Members:

Charli Jayson, Chuck McSorley, Andrea Joel, Tony Chavez and Zak Knight

This Motion was unanimously adopted by the entire Executive Board.

SUMMARY:

- President Merrick purchased and refused to relinquish a series of IATSE Local 44 URLs dating back January 2019 (before he was President of Local 44). For over a year period, but after much delay, dissembling, and a unanimous Executive Board Motion, has finally relinquished most of the URLs.
- President Merrick has improperly used non-Local 44 approved email addresses to appear as if he is authorized to conduct certain business for Local 44 that he is not (click here for actual Local 44 President's Duties). By President Merrick's admission to the Executive Board, the purpose of him retaining control over the iatselocal44. com URL was to allow him to create an email address that appeared as if it was an official Local 44 address. Despite explicit instructions from the Executive Board, President Merrick continued to fabricate Local 44's identity in his digital communications.
- The longstanding policy of Local 44 is to only provide an official email address to the Business Agent, Secretary-Treasurer, and individuals who are employed within the Local 44 office. No one else within Local 44 is eligible for an email address for the purpose of conducting any business. No president or officer other than those mentioned before have an email address from Local 44. President Merrick has been repeatedly told he cannot use any identity of Local 44 to make it appear that he has or has been granted the ability to conduct official Local 44 business.
- President Merrick created and destroyed various Local 44 social media identities that (continued on page 7)

(continued from page 6) were allegedly for the use of Local 44, but to date refuses to disclose what they are or were, what the names are or were, or provide proof that he did, in fact, destroy these identities.

- President Merrick specifically created a new URL to falsify a Local 44 identity that he alone would control, despite his knowledge that this is an unauthorized use of Local 44's identity and intellectual property, as well as in specific violation of the Executive Board's directive to him.
- Over the past six months, several Executive Board Members reached out directly to President Merrick to try to discuss and reason with him to return Local 44's intellectual property, but to no avail.
- Despite being informed that he is exceeding his duties as Local 44's President, Merrick has regularly infringed on other offices and official responsibilities within Local 44.
- President Merrick on multiple occasions was directed to cease such activities by the Executive Board, and continued to either refuse to comply, partially comply or pretend that his actions were an accident. While the Local 44 Executive Board was previously willing to believe that President Merrick was acting innocently, within the last 3 months the Executive Board has lost all confidence in his accounts of his actions and are no longer considered credible.
- On December 24, 2020, President Merrick crossed the line with the entire Executive Board: He publicly took to Facebook to publish the fraternal problems the Executive Board had with his conduct, and in his account seriously mispresented his actions since September 2019.

TIMELINE OF EVENTS FROM JANUARY 2019 TO PRESENT:

- January 26, 2019 While sitting on the Executive Board for the past eight years as a Property Master Executive Board Representative, Brother Merrick creates a Private "Local 44 Leadership (Facebook) Group" that does not include the actual elected leadership of Local 44. This page is not under the Direction or Security of Local 44.
- February 2019 Brother Merrick purchases the URL iatselocal44.com and at some point thereafter uses the URL to create a counterfeit Local 44 email address for unauthorized purposes.
- June 5, 2019 Brother Merrick sworn in as President.
- July 2019 Brother Merrick Purchases a second URL iatselocal44.org.
- At an unknown date believed to be between January 2019 and September 2019
 Brother Merrick creates unauthorized "Local 44 Website, Facebook, Instagram and Twitter account[s]" Despite these accounts bearing Local 44's identity, none are under Local 44's direction and are unsecured. Not one of these identities have been turned over to Local 44 to the present day.
- September 2019 February 2020 The Executive Board meets and invites Website/Social Networking Professionals to discuss new Local 44 Web/Social Networking platform.
- September 11, 2019 After several Executive Board meetings discussing the impropriety of an officer having
 personal control of Local 44 intellectual property and a series of URL/Social Media inquiries, President Merrick
 promises the Executive Board that he will be making a "contribution" to Local 44 of the URLs', website and
 social media accounts.
- Throughout 2019 and most of 2020, President Merrick fails and refuses to fulfill his promise to provide Local 44's intellectual property yet continues to use an unauthorized and fabricated Local 44 email address throughout this period.
- August 19, 2020 Executive Board enquires into the status of President Merrick's transfer of URL's/Social Media to Local 44. Brother Merrick continues to delay the transfer.
- September 9, 2020 Executive Board discusses the status of URL/Social Media transfers. Brother Merrick continues to delay the transfer. Vice President Hennessey, on behalf of the Board, officially contacted President Merrick about the transfer status.
- September 10, 2020 Vice President Hennessey contacts President Merrick to discuss why the URL/social media transfer is still not complete. President Merrick states to VP Hennessey he is busy at work and will need to call back. To date, President Merrick has not returned Vice President (continued on page 8)

(continued from page 7) Hennessey's telephone call.

- October 14, 2020 Executive Board passes a unanimous motion for President Merrick to transfer the intellectual property to Local 44 within in thirty days and be reimbursed for out-of-pocket expenses for securing URLs. President Merrick again agrees to abide by the Executive Board's Motion.
- November 11, 2020 The Board inquires again if the URL transfer is complete. Brother Merrick continues to block the URL transfer.
- November 11, 2020 The Board unanimously passes a motion to send a letter to President Merrick demanding the status of URL and Social Media Transfer.
- December 4, 2020 The Executive Board sends electronic correspondence regarding status of URL's (iateselocal44.com and .org) and Social Media Transfer which was (confirmed) received/ opened by President Merrick.
- December 5, 2020 President Merrick creates a third unauthorized URL (iatselocal44.net). The third domain name was created for specific purpose of continuing to engage in unauthorized activities in contravention of the Executive Board's directive to cease such activity and relinquish all Local 44 intellectual property.
- December 7, 2020 President Merrick attempts to transfer iatselocal44.org and .net to Local 44 while continuing to withhold iatselocal44.com.
- December 8, 2020 Local 44 contacts President Merrick notifying him the transfer did not go through and further explains that Local 44 has not received the URLs nor the Social Media pages he has created.
- December 8, 2020 Local 44 is able to partially extract two domain names in the transfer but learns a third unauthorized domain was created (iatselocal44.net) by President Merrick.
- December 8, 2020 Local 44 asks President Merrick for an explanation why he bought a third domain name in violation of Local 44's directives, to provide the Local 44 social media account identities/information and why iatselocal44.com has not been transferred per the Executive Board Motion. President Merrick fails to respond.
- December 8, 2020 Local 44 learns that Brother Merrick is no longer forwarding iatselocal44.com (stating "this website is under development.") to Local 44's official website, Local44.org.
- December 16, 2020 The Executive Board sends electronic correspondence which is opened by President Merrick detailing the official events that have taken place to date and provides a final deadline to transfer all Local 44 intellectual property before December 21, 2020 at 3PM. If all intellectual property is not transferred to Local 44, the Executive Board warns a public letter of censure will be published to Local 44 members describing President Merrick's actions to date.
- December 21, 2020 Local 44 is informed that the domain iatselocal44.com has not been transferred in whole to Local 44. Local 44 is provided a limited power to use the URL as a "IT technician."
- December 22, 2020 While sorting out the complete transfer of iatselocal44.com, Local 44 learns President Merrick has a fourth 44 URL that was undisclosed and created February 2019.
- December 22, 2020 Local 44 officially secures iatselocal44.com but does not possess the Local 44 website nor social media pages Merrick had created (as required by the Executive Board action). President Merrick has never complied with the Executive Board's directive to return the website and identify social media properties.
- December 23, 2020 Local 44's Executive Board writes the final electronic correspondence to President Merrick (reception/opening confirmed) titled "Continuing Issues with Local 44's Intellectual Property and Identity" outlining the findings of a fourth URL created by Merrick explaining the confusion and frustration his Board colleagues are having with this entire matter offering up a last deadline of December 29, 2020 at 5PM to disclose and/or transfer any and all Local 44 intellectual property.
- December 24, 2020 President Merrick publishes a dishonest account of his actions on social media and further politicizes his conduct. President Merrick continues his refusal to comply with the Executive Board motions, despite that he had repeatedly and long promised to do so.
- December 29, 2020 President Merrick provides no further transfer of Local 44 intellectual property to the Executive Board.
- December 30, 2020 A Special Executive Board Meeting is held and a Vote of No Confidence regarding Local 44's President Dutch Merrick is unanimously approved due to his actions contradicting the oath of his office, disregard of Local 44's Constitution and By-Laws, and loss of confidence in his leadership and honesty by all of his colleagues on the Executive Board.

Members Questions About the Executive Board's "Vote of No Confidence" of Dutch Merrick

Question:	Is the office of President a paid position?
Answer:	No. The President is not paid or salaried, nor has it ever been. Certain approved expenses are
	reimbursed.
Question:	What are the main responsibilities of the position of President of Local 44?
Answer:	The title "President" itself has led to some real confusion among our members and requires clarification. The role of the president is defined in Local 44's Constitution and By-Laws. The President is the chair of the Executive Board and conducts those meetings. Virtually every significant presidential duty is confined to chairing Executive Board or membership meetings, signing checks for the Local, and appointing committees with Executive board approval. The lion's share of the President's duties are found in the Constitution and By-Laws at Article VIII, Sec. 1 President, Paragraph L Chair Responsibilities, (Link to Local 44 Constitution & By-Laws).
Question:	So, the President doesn't conduct business for Local 44?
Answer:	No.
Question:	The President doesn't represent member's issues for Local 44?
Answer:	No. Please contact the Business Agent's office about contract violations or representational issues.
Answer.	No. Thease contact the Dusiness Agent's once about contract violations of representational issues.
Question:	le the Level 11 President a policy making position?
-	Is the Local 44 President a policy making position?
Answer:	No. The President is not permitted to take any position during debates and meetings. If the President decides to take a position during debate or discussion in any such meeting, the President must relinquish the gavel and cease to function as President during debate over that question. This is in keeping with the requirement that the President rise above the fray, govern meetings with a neutral deportment, and not engage in debate. When the President engages in debate, he ceases being President until that question is resolved – Another officer fulfills that role either temporarily or for the rest of the meeting.
Overtions	W/by dependent the Local 44 Dependent have an americal address?
Question:	Why doesn't the Local 44 President have an email address?
Answer:	The President does not do business on behalf of Local 44, so there is no reason for it. To be clear, no President has ever had an email address or Local 44 cell phone. Only employees on payroll who work at Local 44 have a Local 44 email address.
Question:	Why do we call the position President?
Answer:	This terminology can be counter intuitive outside of the craft union setting or for those who are unfamiliar with the Constitution and By-Laws. What is usually titled President is fulfilled within the Local 44 context as Business-Agent, and in certain obligations of Secretary-Treasurer. The Business-Agent and Secretary-Treasurer positions divide the chief executive officer and chief financial officer functions. The Business-Agent has most (but not all) of the tasks of a CEO and the Secretary-Treasurer has most (but not all) of the tasks of a CFO.
Question:	What exactly does "no confidence" mean?
Answer:	The first thing is to refer to the motion of no confidence and supporting documents that are posted here. But, in summary, President Merrick has lost support of the entirety of the Executive Board. The vote of no confidence is a statement that the Executive Board has lost so much confidence in his conduct as President that it would be better if he resigned or otherwise left office. His performance has been persistently unacceptable. Therefore, the Executive Board has no confidence in Dutch Merrick as President.



MOTIONS OF THE EXEC

IATSE Local 44 invites and encourages all members in good standing to take interest in their Union's business. One of the best ways to do so is by reviewing your Local's Executive Board Meeting minutes. All you need to do is follow Article VIII, Powers and Duties Section 4 Secretary/Treasurer paragraph K (I) Minutes and Log of Motions of Local 44's Constitution and By-Laws. The article states: "Any *member in good standing who submits* a written request to schedule an appointment to review a copy of the minutes or the log of motions may do so."
